**Re: PRE-REGISTRATIONS/ FIP JUNIOR WORLD CUP 2025, Reus, Spain – 29 September to 4 October 2025**

Dear Members,

We extend our heartfelt congratulations to each of you on reaching this remarkable milestone — **a record-breaking 62 national teams** have pre-registered for the FIP Junior World Cup 2025.

Following the close of the pre-registration period, please find below the ranking of the Boys' and Girls' teams.

Due to the high number of participating countries, a qualification phase will be introduced. Additionally, please note that **the payment deadline to confirm your pre-registration has been extended to 18 July 2025.**

## 2. Qualification distribution and places

Following the closing of the registration confirmation window, the definitive competition dates, game formats for each continent will be determined.

- Dates: Friday 26 September – 28 September.
- Location: Reus, Spain.

Asia – Africa:

Boys

- Places: 1
- Countries (7): Egypt, Senegal, Japan, Lebanon, Philippines, Thailand, UAE.

Girls

- Places: 1
- Countries (5): Japan, Lebanon, Philippines, Thailand, UAE.

Europe:

Boys

- Places: 2
- Countries (11): Austria, Czechia, Estonia, Finland, Germany, Great Britain, Netherlands, Hungary, Norway, Poland, Switzerland.

Girls

- Places: 2
- Countries (9): Belgium, Estonia, Finland, Great Britain, Germany, Netherlands, Hungary, Norway, Poland.

America:

Boys

- Places: 1
- Countries (3): USA, Uruguay, Venezuela.

Girls

- Places: 1
- Countries (3): USA, Ecuador, Venezuela.

## 3. National team delegation

Boys and Girls: a maximum of twelve (12) players, two (2) coaches, and one (1) delegate:

- From two (2) to four (4) players for the age category under 14,
- From two (2) to four (4) players for the age category under 16,
- From two (2) to four (4) players for the age category under 18,

Players are eligible to participate with a national team provided that they are citizens / permanent nationals of the country concerned and:

- have never represented any other country in a Padel World Cup event;
- have not represented any other country in the thirty-six (36) months before the event.

Moreover, their age must be included in the category they are playing in.

For a player to be eligible in a category, he/she must not exceed X years old (depending on the category: under 14, under 16, under 18) in the course of the year in which the competition is held.

In order to participate in the Team's Competitions, a National Team must be comprised of a minimum of six (6) players, two per category, both in the boys and girls' category.

If a National Team does not reach the minimum requirement of 6 members, it will be entitled to participate in the National Pairs competition only.

#### 4. Registration fee

- Final Phase
  - 900 euros for both boys' and girls' teams
  - 700 euros for one team only (boys' or girls')
- Qualification
  - 500 euros for both boys' and girls' teams.
  - 350 euros for one team only (boys' or girls')

*Note: Teams that qualify for the Final Phase are required to pay the differential amount of the entry fee.*

#### 5. Open by National Pairs

Main Draw:

- Each National Federation participating in the final phase of the National Teams competition will be allocated 2 places (2 pairs) in the Main Draw for each category.
- Each National Federation in the qualification phase of the National Teams competition will be allocated 1 place (1 pair) in the Main Draw for each category.

Qualification Draw:

- It will consist of 32 pairs.
- FIP Promises ranking will be used to establish the entry list for the Qualification Draw.

Participating pairs must meet the following requirements:

- Each of the players in the pair must be in possession of a valid federation license issued by the same Association/National Federation affiliated with FIP.
- Each of the players that make up the pair may register in the category that corresponds to him/her by age or in the next higher one.
- Categories: U14, U16 and U18

Registration fee:

- 50 Euros / pair

September 15

- Deadline to submit the flight plans of each National Team
- Deadline to submit the transportation requests

September 26

- Deadline for justified injured changes on the National team's rosters
- Start of the qualification stages

September 28

- Captains meeting
- Opening ceremony

September 29

- Start of the competition
